## Programs. Intake dates in January, April, July and September

Title: **Master of Hotel Management**  
Duration: 1.5 years (student already hold a hospitality management bachelors degree)  
Structure: 4 terms: 4 academic (12 weeks each)  
Language: The program is taught in English

Title: **Bachelor of Business (International Hotel Management or International Event Management)**  
Duration: 2.5 years (equivalent in academic hours to a 3 year degree)  
Structure: 10 terms: 6 academic (12 weeks each) and 4 practicum terms ( 2 x 20 weeks)  
Industry practicum: 2 x 20 week periods of paid placement in industry  
Language: The program is taught in English

Title: **Associate Degree of Business (International Hotel Management or International Event Management)**  
Duration: 2 years  
Structure: 8 terms: 4 academic (12 weeks each) and 4 practicum terms (2 x20 weeks)  
Industry practicum: 2 x 20 week periods of paid placement in industry  
Language: The program is taught in English
