Dual Award / Postgraduate Program:

Post Graduate Diploma / Master in Business Administration (MBA), jointly managed by BHMS and City University of Seattle, USA and held at BHMS in Switzerland. The MBA courses are provided by the faculty of City University, and the degree is issued by the City University of Seattle, one of the Northwest's largest, private universities with over 40,000 graduates worldwide, and accredited by NWCCU. A two-year program, based on two intensive study periods of 6 months each at the BHMS campus in Lucerne and Zurich, Switzerland, and two paid internship periods of 4-6 months each in the Swiss Hospitality Industry.
