They also undertake paid industry placements with employers in Australia and abroad.

Blue Mountains offers a three-year Bachelor of Business (International Hotel & Resort Management) degree quality endorsed by The University of Queensland. The undergraduate degree is delivered in fast-track, intensive mode in two and a half years with articulation pathways to the Masters program at its associated school in Canberra, the Australian International Hotel School.

The School is located in the Blue Mountains, one of Australia's most spectacular and popular tourism destinations, just west of Sydney. The region offers excellent recreational and employment opportunities as well as being an extended classroom for field trips and research.

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Programs. Intake dates in January, April, July and September

Title: **Bachelor of Business (International Hotel and Resort Management)**
Duration: 2.5 years (equivalent in academic hours to a 3 year degree)
Structure: 10 terms: 6 academic (12 weeks each) and 4 practicum terms (2 x 20 weeks)
Industry practicum: 2 x 20 week periods (paid full wages if the placement is in Australia)
Language: The program is taught in English

Title: **Associate Degree of Business (International Hotel and Resort Management)**
Duration: 2 years
Structure: 8 terms: 4 academic (12 weeks each) and 4 practicum terms (2 x20 weeks)
Industry practicum: 2 x 20 week periods (paid full wages if the placement is in Australia)
Language: The program is taught in English
